Staff & leadership in the Town of Cohasset continually explore opportunities to improve our community. Through the Master Plan Implementation Committee (MPIC) Elm Street Corridor Working Group, with assistance from consultants from Weston & Sampson, the Town has developed a conceptual plan to update the Elm St. corridor with improved aesthetic, pedestrian, cycling, and vehicular features.

A third and final public workshop for Phase 1 has been **rescheduled for Thursday, November 18, 2021, (Postponed from October 28, 2021) from 7:00-8:30pm** to present the Working Group recommendation on corridor layouts and improvements based on feedback and input.

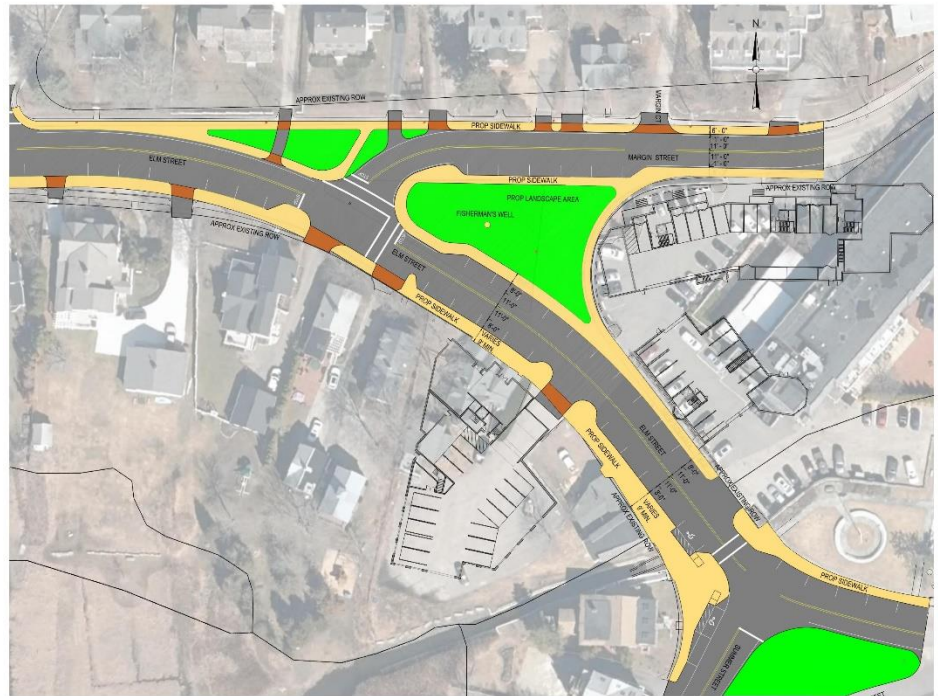


Figure 1: Recommended Reconfigured Intersection at Cohasset Harbor end of Elm St. Corridor

The recommended improvements feature a reconfigured intersection at the Cohasset Harbor end of Elm Street (pictured in Figure 1) along with expanded sidewalks and other streetscape improvements along the corridor.
