Chapter ___ Aquaculture Bylaw

§ ___-1 **Powers of the Select Board regarding taking of eels, shellfish, ~~h~~ and sea worms, moss, kelp and other aquaculture.**

The Select Board shall have authority to promote, control, regulate or prohibit the taking of eels and any and all kinds of shellfish, ~~and~~ sea worms and aquaculture, within the limits of the Town of Cohasset in accordance with Chapter 130 of the General Laws and acts in addition thereto and amendment thereof.

§ ___-2 **Powers of the Select Board regarding licenses for shellfishing.**

The Select Board shall have the authority to grant licenses to plant, grow, dig and take shellfish and to plant shells for catching seed within the Town of Cohasset, in accordance with Chapter 130 of the General Laws and acts in addition thereto and amendment thereof.

§ ___-3 **Powers of the Select Board regarding fisheries.**

The Select Board shall have authority to act exclusively in the exercise of all the rights, privileges and authority conferred by G.L. Chapter 130, with respect to such fisheries within the Town of Cohasset, make appropriations as provided in G.L. Chapter 130, Section 54, and exercise such other control, privileges and responsibilities as are granted in other sections of G.L. Chapter 130 pertinent thereto.

§ ___-4 **Powers of the Select Board to enact regulations.**

The Select Board shall have authority to enact regulations not contrary to law for fisheries as it deems expedient, including the times, places, methods, purposes, uses, sizes, quantities and any other particulars of such taking, and may grant permits or licenses, and establish the fees therefor in accordance with G.L. Chapter 130, Section 52.
