**Licenses/Permits/Events-One Day Liquor License-Carriage House Nursery School-Annual Fundraiser**

Alisha Campbell from Carriage House Nursery reviewed the Annual Parent Fundraiser for the school on May 13, 2022. **Motion by Select Member Dippold to approve a one-day liquor license for the Annual Parent Fundraiser on May 13, 2022, from 6-10 p.m., seconded by Select Member Creighton. Roll Call Vote; All aye.**

**Use of Town Common-Display of Flags-Balance Studio**-Applicant Kellie Lynch owner of Balance Studio is requesting permission to display Ukraine Flags on the common. She is partnering with Global Empowerment Mission to help the people in Ukraine. The Board had a lengthy discussion with where the flags should be put and the dates. **Motion by Select Member Dippold to allow Balance Studios to insert flags on the town common for a period between April 30<sup>th</sup> through June 25<sup>th</sup> subject to working with the town and Memorial Day events and Senior pictures, seconded by Select Member Creighton. Roll Call Vote; All aye.**

**Presentation from School Facilities Committee**-Chair of School Facilities Committee Jason Earls gave the Board an overview of what they have done to date. Architects from Ai3 will review their findings with the Board. Representatives from Ai3 Troy Randall and Julie Rahilly reviewed their information gathering, the existing conditions of the schools, the physical building evaluations, and the educational program evaluations. Based on their study, they believe the Cohasset Middle-High School should be considered for a comprehensive renovation and addition or new construction as defined by the Massachusetts School Building Authority and its core program. The Board had a lengthy discussion. Jason Earls advised the Board they are looking for the Board to vote on the Statement of Interest by the deadline of April 29<sup>th</sup>. The Board agreed to put the topic on the April 26<sup>th</sup> agenda.
